Audio/Visual Team Overview:

The audio/visual team is crucial to the smooth and effective running of our Sunday services. We need to be able to see and hear what is going on in order to engage and take part in our weekly act of worship. We are looking for more members of the congregation who are willing and able to learn how to operate the sound desk.

Time commitment: One Sunday per month. Arriving at church around 9:30am to set up.

Responsibilities:

- To receive teaching from Andrew on how to use the audio/visual equipment.
- To set up and run the audio/visual equipment during the Sunday morning service
 - Preparing and operating microphones; displaying/changing song words on screen; playing any video clips which may be required; on occasions where we do not have a worship team, to play worship songs through the sound system.
- To liaise with those running the service about any special requirements (eg video clips)
- To attend the pre-service briefing/time of prayer at 10:15.
- To ensure all the equipment is switched off at the end of the service.
